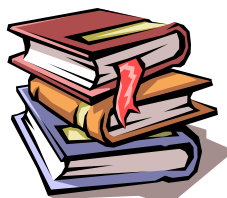

MAPAN

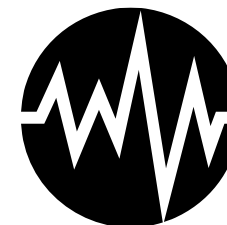
